The learning outcomes-based curriculum framework (LOCF) for a B.Sc. degree in Biochemistry is intended to provide a broad framework within which the biochemistry programme is designed such that it enables students to acquire a skill set that helps them understand and appreciate the field of biochemistry. The structure or design of this framework shall ensure a high standard of the Honours degree in Biochemistry in the University. It shall subsequently pave the way for periodic updation and review of the programme, all within the boundaries of the set framework. This programme specification is intended as a reference point for prospective students, current students, examiners and academic and support staff involved in delivering the programme and enabling student development and achievement. Program learning outcomes are the central organizing features of student learning. They are developed from the complex interaction of a range of competing and complementary factors. Since program learning outcomes can only be achieved and demonstrated through component courses, course learning outcomes and their assessment are integrally related to program learning outcomes. The LOCF in Biochemistry aims to achieve this important aspect of a modern teaching programme.
