Greetings from Help The Blind Foundation

Hope you are doing well in the midst of this unprecedented pandemic and so are the members of faculty as well as other members of staff and all the families.

We are happy to partner with you all these years in ensuring availability of university education to your visually Impaired (VI) students. As you may be aware, we at Help The Blind Foundation have been working with around 200 colleges all over the country in 12 states helping around 2500 Visually Impaired students every year for their higher education.

This year also we intend to continue our efforts by working closely with colleges like yours to bring more VI students into the higher education field. We estimate that we would be helping around 3000 students during the ensuing academic year. We shall be pleased to take up an increased number of VIs from your College for our sponsorship programme. We have also been conducting skills training with our EMET (Education, Mobility and Employability Training) programme in select colleges for around 500 students by providing add on training to them in areas like computers, communicative English and other life skills like Mobility and Personality Development etc.,

In view of the pandemic and the consequent lock down etc., and without waiting for the colleges to open fully, we have decided to start our sponsorship programme and thus ensure that the students get the support from us quite early in the academic year. While we are eagerly looking forward to meeting you, the faculty and the students in person, taking a worst case scenario basis, we are preparing to start the programme 'on line' and take it to its completion by disbursing the sponsorship amount by directly crediting it to your college account for disbursement to the student. Sponsorship can be applied online through our web site [www.helptheblind.in](http://www.helptheblind.in) from 1st October 2020.

To begin with, our volunteers are getting trained to help the candidates fill up online application forms and attach the required documents as attachments and scrutinize them online before forwarding to our office in Chennai. We shall also arrange to get your certificates of bonafide student status on an online format, thus making your work easier. The interviews with the students will be held online and the sponsorship amounts will be credited to the college account by direct transfer.

As all these online methods will involve close and frequent exchange of information with your establishment, we would request you to designate a person from the faculty /administration a coordinator through whom our volunteer(s) can maintain close contact and apprise you of the status of the sponsorship of each of your students.

We assure you our full support in your efforts in providing quality university education to all your students, particularly the visually impaired. Kindly keep us informed of their progress and your inputs as to how our services can be improved for the betterment of the VI students.

We have attached a list of students from your college in the II and III year who are beneficiaries of our sponsorship programme and shall be obliged to get a confirmation of the details therein. On receipt of your confirmation and an application from the concerned student, we shall process their sponsorship application and sanction and remit the amount to their bank account directly.

We also look forward to the list of new students once they are admitted into the college for their degree programme and their applications will also be processed and the sponsorship amount remitted to the respective bank accounts.

We have also attached a few materials that will give you an idea of our organization and the activities that we undertake for the betterment of the lives of the VI students.

Thanking you again for your support and looking forward to more areas of cooperation between your college and our Foundation with the ultimate aim of transforming the lives of the visually impaired.
