






Webinar on "Know Your Rights" in collaboration with ITC Vivel on June 29, 2021

- 4. Dr. Avneet Singh, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Physics






Webinar on "Introduction of Blockchain" in collaboration with the Inblox Academy on August 14, 2020





