Orientation program of Centre for Promotion of Inclusivity on January 15, 2021






Orientation program of National Service Scheme (NSS) on January 12, 2021




At the end, with irresistible aim & explicit vision, another program by WDC ended with flying wings.





Orientation program of Entrepreneurship Development Cell on December 05, 2020









Orientation program of Enactus on November 28, 2020

Orientation program of Placement Cell on November 21, 2020




