Steps taken by department to teach advanced students.


1. During pandemic teachers provided material by scanning books and giving pdfs of chapters to students.
2. Teachers provided links to download online journals like Down to Earth, Focus and Geography and You.
3. Teachers also shared links of important websites like Jstore, DOAJ (**Directory of Open Access Journals**), britannica.com, wiley online library, Indian Journals, Sage Journals etc.
4. Department shared links of online free courses conducted by IIRS (Indian Institute of Remote Sensing), SWAYAM by HRD, NASSCOM, ICT by MHRD, iGOT by DIKSHA portal and AICTE ELIS portal.
5. Department also shared links to join important online seminars, workshops and training courses conducted in Shivaji College and other colleges to students.
6. Department provided laptops to students, to take classes, to access online sources, for those who cannot afford smart phones.
7. Teachers Used online Google quiz methods for conducting class test.

Steps taken by department to teach weak students

1. Teachers took help of platforms like zoom, google meet and msteams to teach students and provide study material to them.
2. With the help of power point presentations teachers taught online and shared study material online through online platforms like zoom, google meet and msteams, gmail, whatsapp and telegram.
3. Teachers also took extra online classes for needy students.
4. College took new initiative of SPACE online platform, where all teachers can share study material to students and keep record of attendance, assignments and internal assessment. Students can also access same platform for study material & class notes and to submit their assignments.
5. Department created small Mentor groups, where students can discuss their personal and professional problems to their Mentors.
6. Department also oriented students to handle online exams and minimise their mental pressure. Hence, students can adjust with online mode of examination.
7. Departments switched completely on msteams during beginning of new semester in november 2020 for taking regular online classes, where teachers can take classes online, download online attendance, share study material, upload assignments and

mark/grade them online and at the same time students can access same platform to join classes, to upload assignments and to download study material.

8. More use of online mediums to keep engaging students with group assignments and oral presentations to develop healthy and intellectual relation among them.
9. Department provided laptops to students, to take classes, to access online sources, for those who cannot afford smart phones.

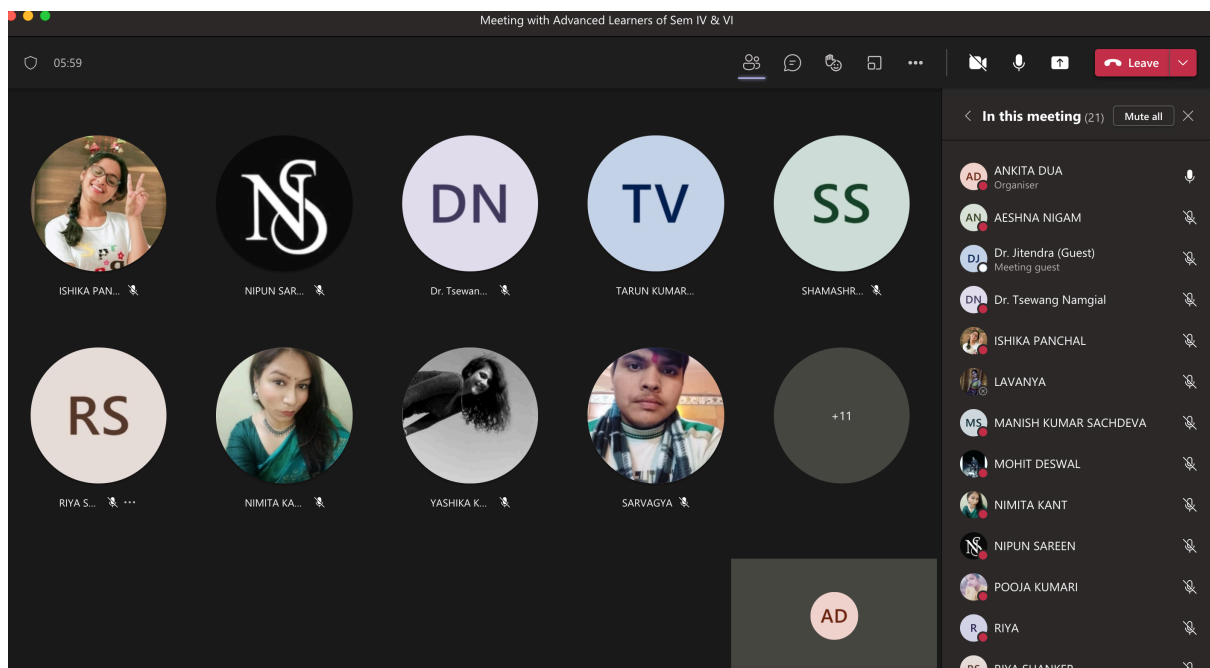


