During the 2 hours of the workshop, the speaker talked about various laws & legal issues with experiences from her personal & professional life. With an amazing response from the audience, a lot of questions were asked to Ms. Mansi and a good discussion thus prevailed. Coming towards the end of the workshop, the audience were filled with immense information, which will help them to broaden their horizons and make them aware of the know-how to deal with such issues in their surroundings.

The CFPI (Centre for Promotion of Inclusivity), Shivaji College, in collaboration with the Sarvodya Collective organized "Speak Up 3.0," on 10th February 2023 at 11 am in the Auditorium of Shivaji College.

The event brought together people from diverse backgrounds and inspired students. The speakers at the event were:

•Mr. Pranav Bakshi - Associate Digital Producer-Contractor at Thomson Reuters and the firstever Fashion Model with Autism to have walked the ramp for Lakme Fashion Week

•Mr. Manish Kumar - A Government School Teacher and Writer

•Ms. Rashmi Jayashankar - Psychologist/Researcher

•Mr. Anurag Singh - Data Engineer

Mr Pranav Bakshi enlightened the students with his experience as a person with autism. He shared his stories about the struggle he faced in becoming the first fashion model with autism to have walked the ramp for Lakme Fashion Week. His mother, Ms. Anupama also shared her experience as a mother of a differently abled person. She shared with the students the discrimination she had witnessed her son go through. Mr. Manish Kumar spoke on the need of inclusion of the differently-abled people in our society. He highlighted their lack of proper representation in mainstream Hindi Literature and in Bollywood. Ms. Rashmi Jayashankar spoke about the culture of silencing the LGBTQ identities and their experiences. She reminded that the LGBTQ was much strongly applauded in the architecture, art and literature of the pre-British India. Mr. Anurag Singh spoke about minority experiences and inclusion. He noted that we are all unique but not so different at the same time. He conveyed the message of kindness by stating that once should not overlook their privileges and should use that to help those in need in every way possible.

It was followed by a seminar on social entrepreneurship presented by Muskan Kaninwal, the Founder of Love Vastra. The participants learned about the various dynamics of social entrepreneurs through an impactful session by Muskan Kaninwal. We were able to provide an audience to the products of Love Vastra, along with providing an insight to the audience regarding a major issue of Domestic Violence and its impact on not just the abused but also the community. She talked about her beautiful journey in making the brand and the struggles that women entrepreneurs face and her arduous efforts to overcome these obstacles. She also talked about the importance of supporting local and small businesses. Ms. Kaninwal's speech was followed by, much to the delight of the audience, a melodious performance by singer Amit Kumar Singh, which brought the crowd to an ecstatic frenzy. To say that everyone enjoyed the performance, would be an understatement. To ensure that there was no lack of fun activities, various stalls were also set up, selling items such as oxidised jewellery, and services like hair braiding. ## 8. LANGUAGE WORKSHOP



## 9. WORKSHOP ON 'RESEARCH IN ECONOMICS' 2022

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The society's vision was to enrich the audience of the event with information on the process of carrying out a research project, right from beginning with an idea up to eventually publishing it. Together with the department teachers, the society successfully organized the research workshop bifurcated into two sessions-" GETTING STARTED WITH RESEARCH" and "ACADEMIC WRITING".

The event was held on 26 September, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. IST in the college auditorium. Almost 80 students and teachers actively participated in the Workshop. The Workshop was led by Dr. Priyanka Arora, a visiting faculty at Ashoka University, outstanding in economic research. She has worked on the role of culture in the economy, its interactions with the economic sphere and the implications of these on economic development with a Machiavellian touch of genius.

She reminded the audience to ensure if their research adds to the knowledge stock in the sphere. Thereby, she stressed the necessity of a literary review to avoid plagiarism. In addition, she demonstrated live, how to search for already published papers and articles in Google Scholar. She advised that since a brilliant title, abstract, introduction and conclusion adds extra flair to the paper, much attention be given to it. She listed a number of methodologies that could be adopted for writing a research paper. In addition, she demonstrated live the usage of the typesetting software, LaTeX, beginning from opening an account to coding in it.



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
## 11. SELF-DEFENCE WORKSHOP

Certificate Distribution after the Workshop

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






## 12. Seminar on Society, Abuse and Gender





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


# **17.WORKSHOP ON DATA AND ANALYTICS**


