#### iv. Event Report

The Center for Promotion of Inclusivity (CFPI) of Shivaji College, in collaboration with the Sarvodya Collective, organized a Workshop on Neurodiversity on 9th November 2022.

The Convenor of CFPI, Dr. L Gitarani Devi and Dr. Preeti Tewari felicitated the keynote speaker, Ms. Pooja Sharma and Mr. Vinayak with a token of gratitude. Ms Pooja Sharma is the founder of Sarvodya Collective – a platform working for the neurodiverse community. She also runs the online campaign Inclusive Duniya, through which she informs the experiences and sensibilities of people who are slow in intellectual development. The CFPI is the collaborative partner of Sarvodya Collective. Both the collectives have signed an MoU to sensitize the people about the conditions of intellectual disability and neurodiversity.

The session began with Ms. Pooja Sharma interacting with the audience to assess their awareness about neurodiversity and inform them about conditions of intellectual disabilities. She spoke on "Neurodiversity and Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities". This session was developed further by engaging the participants to design comic strips on the theme of neurodiversity. The event saw enthusiastic participation of more than fifty students.



#### iv. Event Report

The CFPI (Centre For Promotion of Inclusivity), Shivaji College, in collaboration with the Sarvodya Collective organized "Speak Up 3.0," on 10th February 2023 at 11am in the Auditorium of Shivaji College.

The event brought together people from diverse backgrounds and inspired students. The speakers at the event were:

- •Mr. Pranav Bakshi Associate Digital Producer-Contractor at Thomson Reuters and the first-ever Fashion Model with Autism to have walked the ramp for Lakme Fashion Week
- •Mr. Manish Kumar A Government School Teacher and Writer
- •Ms. Rashmi Jayashankar Psychologist/Researcher
- •Mr. Anurag Singh Data Engineer

Mr Pranav Bakshi enlightened the students with his experience as a person with autism. He shared his stories about the struggle he faced in becoming the first fashion model with autism to have walked the ramp for Lakme Fashion Week. His mother, Ms. Anupama also shared her experience as a mother of a differently abled person. She also pointed out the typical image a regular person holds about a person with disability due to lack of awareness and sensitization.

Mr. Manish Kumar spoke on the need of inclusion of the differently-abled people in our society. He highlighted their lack of proper representation in mainstream Hindi Literature and in Bollywood. He emphasised the importance of specially abled people being given the opportunity to present themselves in the entertainment sector.

Ms. Rashmi Jayashankar spoke about the culture of silencing the LGBTQ identities and their experiences. She reminded that the LGBTQ was much strongly applauded in the architecture, art and literature of the pre-British India. She noted that even with Legal Restrictions being lifted, the Queer Community is still facing hardship within different spheres of day-to-day activities.

Mr. Anurag Singh spoke about minority experiences and inclusion. He noted that we are all unique but not so different at the same time. He conveyed the message of kindness by stating that once should not overlook their privileges and should use that to help those in need in every way possible. About 55 students participated in the event.

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





