




GLOBAL ROTI DAY WALK 28 September 2023

Field Visit to "MITR TRUST" 03 July 2023

OBJECTIVE: The Enactus Shivaji College team visited Mitr Trust on 3 July 2023. 


GLOBAL HANDWASHING DAY 15 October 2023


IIRS-ISRO OUTREACH PROGRAMME 14 SEPTEMBER 2023 - 19 JANUARY 2024

FIELD VISIT TO IIT DELHI 15 April 2024

OBJECTIVE: The Department of Botany organised a Field Visit to the Department of Biochemical Engineering and Biotechnology, IIT Delhi on 15 April 2024. 26 students along with their teachers participated in the tour.

OUTCOME: The visit familiarised the students with the development of fermentation process utilising laboratory-scale fermenters established in the Bioprocess laboratory and the UG laboratory. They also witnessed the application of aerobic and anaerobic CSTR for waste treatment. Other facilities of analytical techniques applicable to downstream processing, including TOC-analyser, HPLC-MS, GC-MS, ion exchange chromatography, MALDI-TOF MS situated at the Departmental Instrumentation Lab and Lotus Advanced Analytical Lab were also observed. They also saw ongoing research work on metagenomic analysis and culture of soil microbes at Environmental Genomics Laboratory. Students got an insight into the cutting-edge research by interacting with eminent scientists and scholars. They also learnt of technical detail operation and application of instruments.


