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1. Summer Training Program on Research Methodology 3.0(June 05-July 03, 2023)

The summer training program on research methodology 3.0 was organized by the Department of Biochemistry, Shivaji College, University of Delhi under the aegis of DBTSponsored Star College Scheme with the supervision of Dr. Jayita Thakur, Dr. Sunita Singh, Dr. Renu Baweja, Dr. Usha Yadav and, Dr. Abhijeet Mishra from June 05-July 03, 2023. A total of 29 students participated in this program. The whole program was divided into 5 modules, the first module was taken by Dr. Renu Baweja in which she introduced the participants to research methodology and what a research proposal is all about this was followed by the assignments related to the module. The next module was conducted by Dr. Usha Yadav in which participants were given a clear view of the research and sample design, also they got to know about the literature review, how to develop a hypothesis, and what research plan they have to include in it. These 2 modules were covered in week 1. The next week was taken by Dr. Abhijeet Mishra, he gave a basic idea for the health camp, and how to collect data from that help camp and digitalization of data, this week, the health camp was organized on the premises of Shivaji College. This health camp includes various parameters such as Height, weight, BMI, fat percentage, visceral fat, basic metabolic rate, and body age. He also developed a scientific temperament among students with his thought-provoking questions. The next module was followed by Dr. Jayita Thakur, in which participants learn about many areas of data presentation, data processing, and statistical analysis in the field of biochemistry during the summer training program. Dr. Jayita Thakur held engaging workshops on these issues, giving a piece of insightful information and practical understanding to students. A health camp is also organized in Miranda House for further data collection. During this 3rd week of the program students also got a chance to interact with experts like Dr. Suman Kharbanda, she gave detailed information on how to use Microsoft Excel for data analysis with Dr. Chhavi Sharma, she emphasized the significance of data input and formatting in order to conduct correct analysis. A talk with Dr. Bhupender has conducted for an insight view of Hypothesis Testing, Statistical Tests, and Secondary data analysis.



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The last module of this program was taken by Dr. Sunita Singh, who conducted the session on ethical principles in research. The significance of following these principles was emphasised, particularly in terms of biosafety and ethics compliance. These sessions are more interactive with talks from different experts like Prof. (Dr) Man Singh who talks about Intellectual property rights and Patents with his in-depth knowledge, Dr. Ajay opened the discussion by emphasizing the necessity of thorough and methodical research. He emphasised the need for well-defined research topics, clear objectives, and good preparation guaranteeing a research project's success, and at last, Dr. Arjun gave us a quick overview of the statistical analysis and briefly reviewed the questions submitted in the Google form. All the modules have their own different assignments/tasks which kept the students focused. At last, this summer training program was concluded with a valedictory session in which the feedback of students was taken and the certificates were distributed.

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2. INMAS, DRDO visit Report

An exhibition has been organized on 8th July 2023 in INAMS (Institute of Nuclear Medicine & Allied Sciences) a premier lab of DRDO under supervision of Dr. Himanshu Ojha, a senior scientist at DRDO. About 14 students from the **Department of Biochemistry, Shivaji College along with Dr. Abhijeet Mishra** Asst. Prof., Dept. of Biochemistry participated in this exhibition. The exhibition starts with an introduction to nuclear medicines.

In the first half, they showcase its products and emerging technologies to science graduate students. The main objective of INAMS is the development of radioprotectors, the development of diagnostics and therapeutic approaches using non-invasive imaging techniques, and the neurocognitive and endocrine functional assessment of the human body. They developed Ciprofloxacin Cold Kit for Infection Scintigraphy: 'Diagnobact', light Weight Foldable Stretcher, Lightweight backpack type Army field Cot., Adjuvant Cancer Therapy with 2-Deoxyglucose, UMBRIEL-the UV Herbal Screen for High Altitude. This was continued by a tea break, after this tea break participants get a chance for the lab visit with a clear vision of the CT scan machinery they are using for their experimental work. They also talked about the imaging techniques they are using. The visit was followed by a lunchbreak. After lunch break participants and professors were asked to give feedback, then certificates were given to the participants. This visit to INAMS at DRDO ends with a group photo.



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3. Workshop on Application of Spreadsheet in Business Statistics

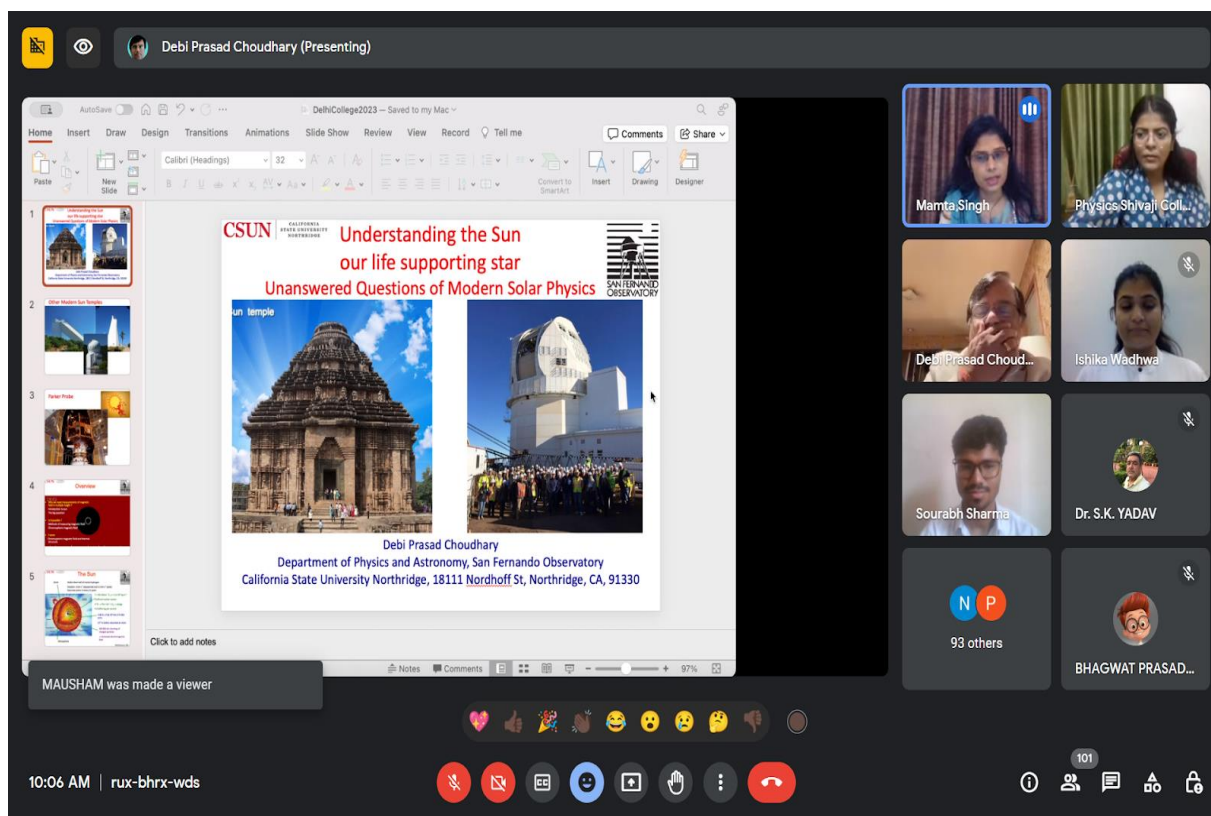

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6. Seminar on “Should the environment matter in Economics?”

On 6th October 2023, the Department of Economics organised a seminar on the topic: “Should the Environment matter in Economics?” followed by an academic quiz event: “The Riddle Rumble”.

The seminar led by our distinguished speaker: Prof. Nandan Nawn (Department of Economics, Faculty of Social Sciences, Jamia Millia Islamia) centred on the critical question of whether the environment should play a central role in economic considerations. It explored various facets of this topic, presenting a comprehensive perspective that incorporates both economic and environmental dimensions. The session encompassed multiple sections, each providing valuable insights.

The first part of the session emphasized the three essential inquiries guiding economic exploration: determining our objectives, identifying the limited resources required to attain these objectives and prioritizing these objectives for resource allocation. It introduced the concept of the production function, a mathematical expression that illustrates how an entrepreneur employs different inputs to produce outputs. Furthermore, the speaker introduced the ecological economics perspective, redefining the production function as an interplay between capital, labour, natural resources, energy, services and waste. It highlighted the interdependence of these elements and the importance of sustainable resource management in economic activities. The second part addressed the challenge of precisely defining sustainability. The session proposed the idea that natural capital should be preserved in some aggregate sense, with losses in one area compensated elsewhere. The essential criterion remains the overall productivity of the accumulated capital, considering its impact on human health, aesthetic value, incomes and the compensation for natural capital depletion.

The session also explored the relationship between environmental and economic assets, highlighting the importance of recognizing the value of natural resources, land and other assets even when they do not have immediate economic benefits.



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The concept of wealth creation was presented as a three-capital model, incorporating natural, produced and human capital. This model considers production, consumption, investment and welfare, recognizing the importance of these capital types for overall prosperity.

The session introduced a framework for assessing and disclosing environmental, social and governance (ESG) attributes, focusing on greenhouse gas emissions, energy consumption and water footprint. At the end, two case studies were presented: India's Green Financing Requirement and Industry body CII seeking clarity on upcoming ESG norms.

In conclusion, the session illuminated the pivotal role of environmental considerations in economics and the need for a sustainable approach to ensure the well-being of society and the planet. It encouraged stakeholders to incorporate these principles into their decision-making processes for a more sustainable and prosperous future.

7. The Riddle Rumble (Academic Quiz)

Riddle Rumble was a captivating academic quiz event that took place, drawing the participation of 42 students from various departments. This quiz, held in the College Auditorium on the online platform Quizizz.com, welcomed students irrespective of their department, making it an inclusive and engaging competition.

The event was divided into two rounds, both designed to challenge the participants with questions ranging from easy to medium difficulty levels. In the first round, participants were faced with a mix of riddles and general knowledge questions, with the task of answering 20 questions within a time limit of 25 minutes. This round set the stage for an exciting competition where knowledge and quick thinking were key.

The second round, the grand finale of Riddle Rumble, focused on testing participants' general knowledge and awareness of current affairs. This round featured 10 questions and only the top 10 winners from the first round were eligible to participate.

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8. Visit to the National Physical Laboratory

On October 4, 2023, the Department of Physics at Shivaji College, accompanied by 37 selected students, had the privilege of visiting the National Physical Laboratory (NPL). The visit provided a unique opportunity for both students and faculty to gain insight into cutting-edge research and applications in the field of physics.

Our visit commenced with a tour of the Cryogenic Liquification Plants at NPL. The guide led us through this facility, where we had the opportunity to witness the preparation of liquid nitrogen and liquid helium from atmospheric gases. A knowledgeable researcher explained the intricate processes involved in producing these cryogenic liquids, emphasizing their critical roles in various scientific and industrial applications. Additionally, several experiments involving liquid nitrogen were conducted, showcasing its remarkable properties.

A knowledgeable researcher enlightened us on the fascinating world of photovoltaics, discussing topics such as PN diodes, silicon, fabrication processes, and the differences between commercial and satellite solar panels. One of the highlights of this segment was the demonstration of ultra-pure silicon solar panels, boasting an impressive efficiency rate of approximately 27% for converting solar energy. We also had the opportunity to observe a standard solar panel with an efficiency of around 22%. This demonstration emphasized the strides being made in the field of solar energy and its potential to revolutionize the renewable energy landscape.

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10. "National Institute of Plant Genome and Research (NIPGR) open-day visit"

A visit to the National Institute of Plant Genome and Research (NIPGR) was organized by the faculty of Shivaji College under the proper guidance of Dr. Abhijeet Mishra, Department of Biochemistry and Dr. Rangnath Ravi, Department of Chemistry on 22nd Dec 2023. Totally 15 students from semesters III and V from different backgrounds, such as biochemistry, botany, and zoology participated in this visit. There are exhibitions of students who are working on different projects or research areas. There are so many research titles that increase the curiosity of students and make them fond of research work. The main purpose of the researcher is to provide a good plant with fewer consequences and environmental or resource consumption. They had worked on plant mechanisms to cope with flooding stress in which they have modified a species of paddy by post-translational modification due to which the crop can survive more than 10 days even in a flood situation they try to stop the plant growth and focus on the photosynthesis process to meet the nutrient requirement in case of a flood. They named the transformed plant as scuba diving rice.

There is another research in which the researchers developed a technique to stop seed aging which is done in the case of orthodox seeds, they identified a protein-repairing enzyme that is responsible for increasing the viability of a seed. A mustard oil extractor was also prepared there to minimize the odour that comes from mustard oil, some people avoid to use mustard oil just because of this Odor. There are many posters presented there which basically show more researches on plant genome and some efficient instruments used during research. This visit increased the scientific temperament among the students and motivated them to work hard in research field. In the end students are also provided with refreshment.

The space station moon mission:- Gateway is a vital component of the NASA-led Artemis missions to return to the Moon and chart a path for the first human missions to Mars. The small space station will be a multi-purpose outpost orbiting the Moon and providing essential support for lunar surface missions, a destination for science, and serving as a staging point for further deep space exploration. NASA is working with commercial and international partners to establish Gateway.

Aditya L1:-The Aditya-L1 mission aims to deepen our understanding of solar phenomena, including the solar corona, photosphere, and the impact of solar winds and related radiation. The spacecraft's instruments have been calibrated during its voyage, sending back X-ray images and particle counts, showcasing its healthy condition.



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At the end the host concluded the program with a doubt session which went very well and all the students participated in it with great enthusiasm. The visit gave us experience of education, learning and motivation. We are honoured that we were a part of this.

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67. Menstrual Hygiene and Prevention of cervical cancer”

The seminar was organized by Department of Biochemistry in collaboration with ENACTUSSHIVAJI on the topic entitled “**Menstrual Hygiene and Prevention of cervical cancer**” on **November 28, 2023** i.e., Tuesday at 11 AM in the college auditorium. The invited speaker was **Dr Ekta Gupta**, Scientist-E, ICMR-NICPR, Noida (UP).

The seminar was attended by 152 students from different disciplines, 10 faculty members of the Department of Biochemistry and ENACTUS SHIVAJI. The aim of the seminar was the student participants about menstrual health and cervical cancer thus enabling them to make informed and proactive choices for their overall well-being.

The seminar commenced with **Dr. Ekta Gupta** engaging the audience, posing a thought-provoking question about the importance and relevance of the discussed topic in recent times. She then delved into a comprehensive exploration of women's health, starting with a brief yet impactful introduction to cervical cancer. Dr. Gupta debunked the common notion surrounding it, emphasizing that it is entirely preventable, contrary to popular belief.

She then passionately addressed puberty changes, and the societal taboo surrounding them. She stressed the need for open conversations and destigmatization, particularly to support young individuals navigating through these changes. The significance of menstrual hygiene emerged as a central theme. She properly highlighted the potential consequences of poor menstrual hygiene, including the risk of cervical intra epithelial neoplasia (CIN).

She went on to talk about Cervical & HPV cancer. In an informative segment, the audience gained a deeper understanding of HPV and its life cycle in the cervix. Common symptoms of cancer were discussed, contributing to the audience's awareness of potential indicators that warrant attention and medical consultation.



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The seminar highlighted various prevention strategies, including the role of vaccines in protection against cervical cancer. She also detailed the various vaccines for cervical cancer available in the market, and the recommended age for taking them.

An integral part of the discussion focused on the importance of cancer screenings, particularly for cervical cancer. Dr. Gupta emphasized the significance of regular screenings such as PAPSMEAR, as a proactive measure in identifying potential health risks early on. Attendees gained insights into the significance of early detection and its role in preventing these diseases.


The seminar concluded with a vibrant interaction, as she graciously answered queries from an engaged and enlightened audience.

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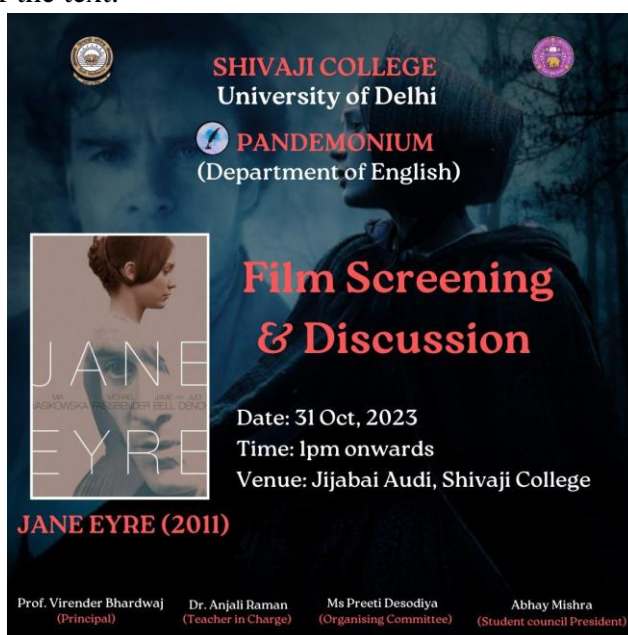
81.Film Screening and Discussion.

The speaker then introduced students to the basics of Git Command line and familiarized them with basic Git commands like git init, git add, git commit, git push and git pull. The students were also introduced to the concept of version control and its importance in tracking changes to the code. The speaker effectively engaged the audience through interactive sessions, live demonstrations, and addressing queries from the participants. After a 15 min break, the speaker introduced the students to GitHub and its significance in software development. Getting them started with setting up a GitHub account - creating repositories, branching, merging, and conflict resolution. The speaker also highlighted best practices and tips for effective use of GitHub.

The workshop concluded with a Q/A session to solve the queries of the participants. The positive feedback and active participation from students demonstrate the value of such practical sessions in supplementing their learning experiences.

Students from physics department of all respective semester along with faculty members joined the film screening at 11:30. Everyone at the screening was excited about the film and had shown great enthusiasm.

After every one sat ,the host welcomed them all with warm greetings and told us about the film and what are its scientific perspectives. 'Gravity ' film is a sci fi and it depicts the life without gravity very beautifully. The movie was not only oriented towards science and technology, it teaches life lessons as well like how positive approach really could help in dealing with any difficult situation.

Gravity is a 2013 science fiction thriller film directed by Alfonso Cuarón, who also co-wrote, co-edited, and produced the film. It stars Sandra Bullock and George Clooney as American astronauts who attempt to return to Earth after the destruction of their Space Shuttle in orbit.

The Space Shuttle Explorer, commanded by veteran astronaut Matthew "Matt" Kowalski, is in Earth orbit to service the Hubble Space Telescope (HST). Dr. Ryan Stone is aboard on her first space mission, to perform a set of hardware upgrades on the Hubble. During a spacewalk, Mission Control in Houston warns Explorer's crew about a rapidly expanding cloud of space debris accidentally caused by the Russians having shot down a presumed defunct spy satellite (see Kessler syndrome) and orders the crew to return to Earth immediately. Communication with Mission Control is lost shortly after as more communication satellites are disabled by debris. The movie follows with how the astronauts struggle to save their lives in such harsh environment with no Gravity.



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At the end of the screening host concluded the program by giving us a warm speech and suggested us to fill the feedback form . The screening gave many experiences like educational, entertaining and learning as well. The film kept us at the edge of our seats and left us with many curiosities about space and science .

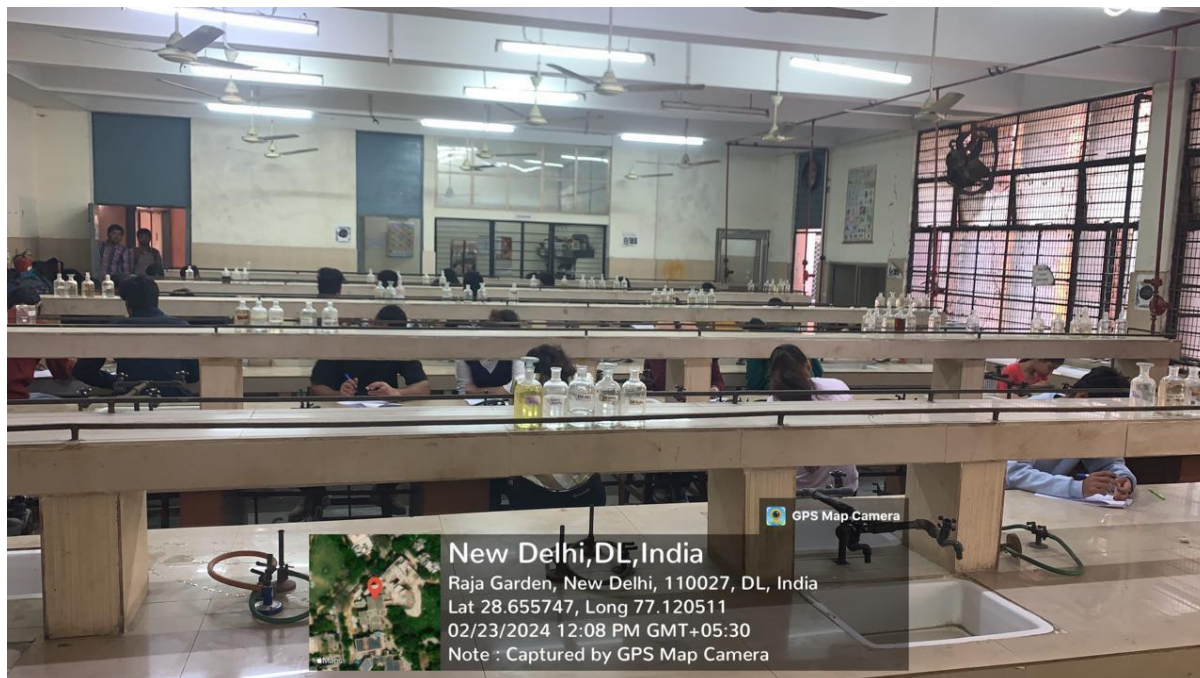

The Department of Chemistry, Shivaji College, University of Delhi, conducted an Add-on Course on "*Understanding Chemistry Using Software*" in online mode on MS Teams. This course was designed to familiarize students with molecular modelling and computational chemistry techniques, equipping them with hands-on experience in using specialized software tools.

The course was structured across four modules:

1. **MolView:** 2D and 3D molecule building, visualization, and spectral analysis.
2. **JMol:** 3D molecular structure building with animations, surfaces, and secondary structure visualization in biomolecules.
3. **Avogadro:** Energy calculations, molecule measurements, and docking pose visualization for biomolecules.
4. **ArgusLab:** Basic geometry optimization, ESP plots, and HOMO/LUMO visualization for structural analysis.

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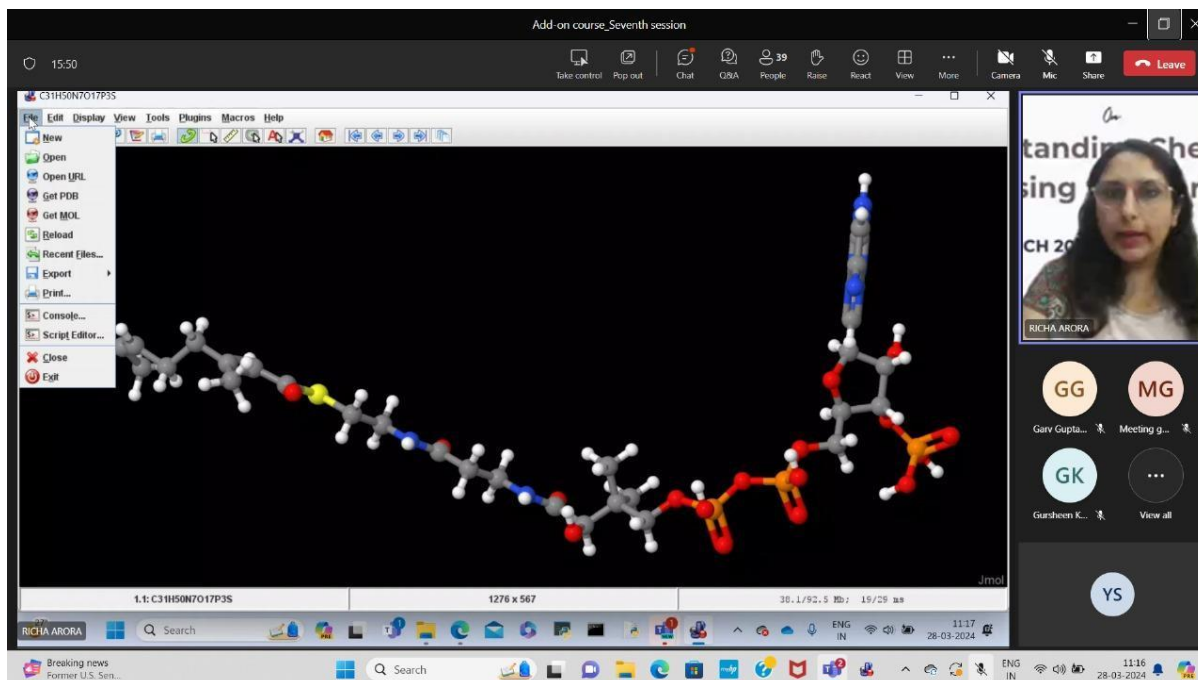
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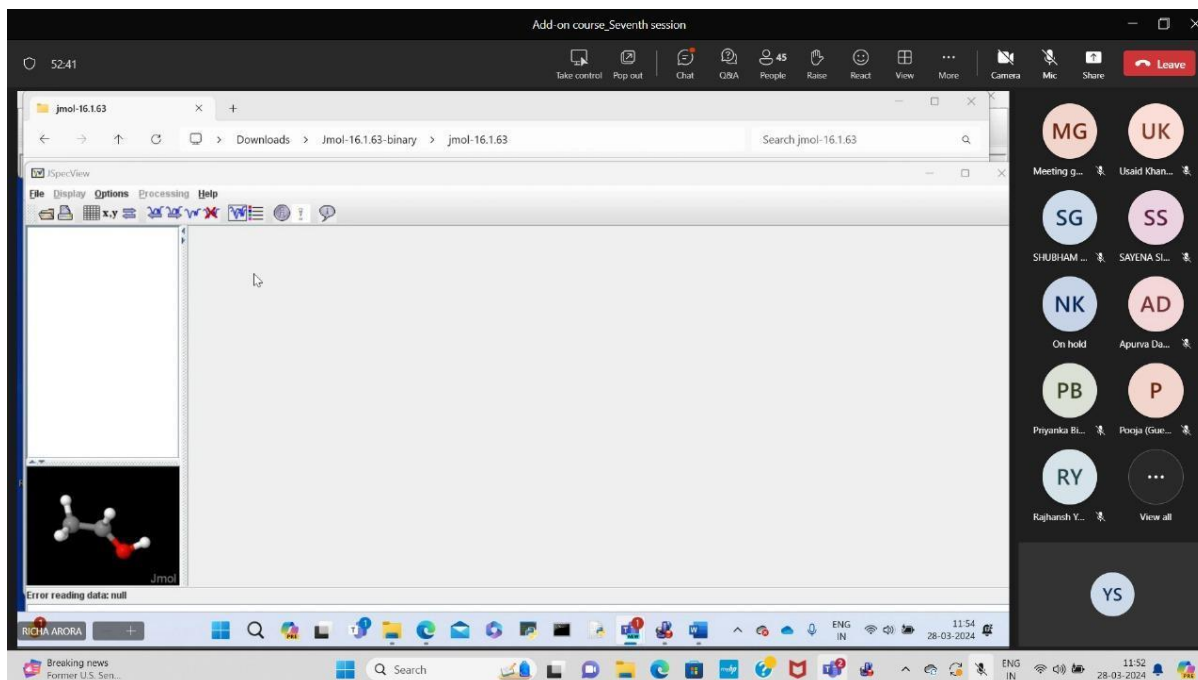
