



Women's Development Cell (WDC) of Shivaji College aims at creating awareness and mobilizing youth to achieve the objective of gender equality. The cell ensured active participation of male faculty and boys of the College towards gender related issues in all the activities endorsed by WDC during the academic year 2016-17.

Women's Development Cell collaborated with many organizations such as One Billion Rising (OBR), Maitri India, MenEngage Delhi, Centre for Advocacy and Research (CFAR) and Nazariya for organizing various awareness programmes throughout the year.

With the objective to condemn violence against women WDC organized an event "AB AUR NAHIN" on August 26, 2016. The event commenced with a workshop on *Domestic Violence* conducted by Maitri India followed by an interactive session on *Engaging Men for Social justice* by Mr. Ahmed Faraz from MenEngage Delhi. Street play Mera *Wajood* organized by Centre for Advocacy and Research challenged the patriarchal systems prevailing in Modern India. The event concluded with poster making competition.

In its earnest attempt to advocate gender equality, WDC organized an event "Mera Wajood" on 7th October, 2016. The event included many sessions with our collaborators. Nazariya, conducted a talk on 'Exploring the Self through the Lens of Gender' which was followed by an interactive session on 'Exploring the layers of masculinities' by MenEngage Delhi and One Billion Rising.

Women's Development Cell, in its efforts to generate awareness against gender related discrimination, organized a Gender Fair, sponsored by UGC, on the theme 'Being a Woman' on February 2nd & 3rd, 2017. The event highlighted WDC's resolve to transform the rigid mindsets that are plagued with patriarchal overtones. This two day Fair comprised of panel discussions and talks by eminent activists working for gender equality, followed by events like flash mob, cultural performances etc. The event was inaugurated by Ms. Kamla Bhasin, South Asia Coordinator, One Billion Rising and famous wrestler cum coach Sh Mahavir Singh Phogat and his wife Smt. Daya Kaur. The inauguration was followed by a panel discussion on "Gender Identity: Myth or Reality" which aimed to critically deliberate on socially constructed perceptions of masculinity and femininity. The fair featured plays by Asmita Theatre Group and Breakthrough along with session by MenEngage, OBR and various inter-college competitive events. The fair concluded with the presentation of Jijabai Achievers' Awards 2017 and release of coffee table book and a documentary. The awards are conferred upon individuals with extraordinary contributions in the field of women safety, health, social security, education, skill enhancement, etc.





Research Methodology and Data Analysis using SPSS/R

The Department of Commerce, Shivaji College in collaboration with Mahatma Hansraj Faculty Development Center organized a one week National level Faculty Development Program on the topic, "Research Methodology and Data Analysis Using SPSS/R" from November 14 to 20, 2019. This rigorous workshop was attended by academicians and research scholars from diverse fields of Commerce, Management, Anthropology, Literature etc. The participants were from over fifteen states/UT of India like Telangana, Nagaland, Gujarat, Puducherry, Delhi NCR etc. making it national FDP in true sense.

The inaugural event of the FDP was graced by Prof. R.K. Singh, Head and Dean, Department of Commerce, Delhi School of Economics as Chief Guest. The guest was extended with the warm welcome by the FDP Coordinator Dr. Ramesh Malik, Department of Commerce, Shivaji College. Dr. Jyoti Bhola, FDP Coordinator from Prof. R. K. Singh addressed on taking FDPs as a learning process and not just as trend. He also discussed as to why in today's era research is the most integral part of Education system.

The main focus of the FDP was on understanding the basics of statistics and research to get the conceptual clarity. The resource persons covered wide range of topics including literature review, questionnaire designing, research design, sampling etc. Hands on training was provided to participants for hypothesis testing using SPSS and R software. The practical training also included parametric like t test, ANOVA and non-parametric test like chi square. The fifth day sessions included theoretical concepts and interpretation of correlation and regression output in SPSS. The resource person also explained the areas of usage of factor analysis and interpretation of computer output. The last day sessions enlightened the participants about the publication of

research papers and informed about the prominent research journals and how to prepare research papers for publication.

The galaxy of experts and professors were the resource persons for the FDP. These included Dr. Ashish Chandra, Dr. H.K. Dangi, Dr. Madan Lal, Dr. Amit Kumar Singh, Associate Professor, Delhi School of Economics, Prof. Tejinder Sharma, Department of Commerce, Kurukshetra University, Dr. Neeru Rathi, Dr. Chirag Malik, Associate Professor, BML Munjal University, Dr. Satish Mittal, Assistant Professor, Gautam Buddha University, Dr. Sonali Yadav, Associate Professor, IBS, Gurugram, Dr. Divya Verma Gakhar and Mr. Narain, Assistant Professor, Faculty of Management Studies.

The Faculty Development Program concluded with the Valedictory session in which Dr. Amit Kumar Singh, Associate Professor, Delhi School of Economics awarded the certificates to the participants on successful completion of the program. Dr. Amit Kumar Singh explained the audience the importance of research and the learnings from such FDPs would help them in many ways.

Sharing their experiences and feedback on the FDP, the participants were highly appreciative of the arrangements of the program and expressed that they not only gathered immense knowledge on the discipline but also learned from the mentors the art of being good teachers in class. The FDP had an additional benefit in the form of networking and bonding amongst participants, which certainly leads to creation of discussion platforms and fertilization of ideas across academia.
