Report of Eco Club 2015-16

ACTIVITIES ORGANISED BY ECO CLUB SHIVAJI COLLEGE DURING 2015-2016

Eco-Club Shivaji College is a highly active society of Shivaji College that organizes a number of environmental awareness programmes and projects from time to time.

Sparrow Conservation Project: House sparrow *Passer domesticus* is a common bird of India. In the recent past its population has rapidly declined in Delhi. It is also a State Bird of Delhi, therefore for sparrow conservation; we have installed nest boxes in different parts of college campus in August 2015. The project is monitored by Dr. Vijay Kumar (Convener, Eco-Club) and Dr. Virat Jolli (Department of Environmental Studies). Though it is not colonized by sparrows however it is being used by Squirrels. Their absence in and around college is worrisome and in next phase we are planning to install feeder boxes to attract sparrows from adjoining areas.

Vermi-composting Unit: Our society is also engaged in making vermi-compost from organic waste. The compost is made using redworms and is maintained under the guidance of Dr. Vijay Kumar. The vermicomposting unit produces excellent quality of compost which is distributed at free of cost among teaching and non-teaching staff.

Paper Recycling Unit: Our Society manages and collects waste paper generated from college and converts it into recycled paper for reuse in the Laboratory. The unit is managed by Dr. Smita Tripathi and Dr. Misha Yadav.

On September 7th 2015 Eco-Club organized “**Pledge to Plant, Adopt & Protect a Tree Campaign**”. The motive of the campaign was to sensitize the students for protection of plants and also to motivate them to participate in afforestation programmes so as to protect Mother Earth from pollution, climate change and global warming. Competitions like Poster making and Slogan Writing were held in which students from different courses participated. The topic of poster making was “**Plant: A Victim**” and the activity was coordinated by Ms. Bharti (Department of Physics) and Dr. Renu Baweja (Department of Biochemistry). For the Slogan Writing Competition, the topic was “**Virksha Dhara Ki Punji Hai**” and it was coordinated by Dr. Smita Tripathi and Dr. Misha Yadav of the Department of Botany. A signature campaign was launched for Pledge to Plant, Adopt and Protect A Tree Campaign for college teaching and non teaching staff. The overwhelming participation of students, Eco-Club Volunteers, Teacher Coordinators had made it a success.

On **Deepawali** festival, Delhi’s air quality suffered due to burning of firecrackers, to spread awareness, our society took initiative and urged all the students to “**Say No To Fire Crackers**”. Our society also runs a wall magazine under the guidance of Dr. Misha Yadav, Department of Botany for spreading environmental awareness among college students.

Eco Club Shivaji College, Organized a **field excursion to Yamuna Biodiversity Park**, New Delhi to celebrate World Wetland Day on 02nd February 2016. The excursion was coordinated by Dr. Vijay Kumar, Dr. Kiran Bamel and Dr. Virat Jolli. Students of B.Sc. (H) Botany Semester-II and Semester -IV along with B.Sc. (H) Zoology Semester-II participated and learnt about the importance of the wetland ecosystem and its ecoservices.

National Seminar on Water and Air Quality in Urban Ecosystem on 22nd march 2016.

Eco Club of Shivaji College observed World Water Day on **22nd March 2016** by organising a "**National Seminar on Water and Air Quality in Urban Ecosystem**". The Seminar was inaugurated by the Keynote address of **Shri C.R Babu**, Professor Emeritus, University of Delhi. Prof. Babu presented his talk on "*Wetlands as Water Resources for Urban Centers*". The seminar had a *Technical Session on Water and Air*. In the Water Session, **Shri A.K. Gosain**, Professor, IIT Delhi delivered a talk on "Issues of Water Pollution in Yamuna, Delhi". The second invited lecture was delivered by Dr. Rita Kumar, Scientist Emeritus, IGIB, Delhi. She presented her talk on "*Biotechnological Endeavours Towards Waste Water Management*". In the *Technical Session on Air*, Shri B. Sengupta, Former Member Secretary, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), Delhi delivered his talk on "*Air Quality Concerns and Options to Improve Air Quality in India*". Later on **Shri. G. V. Subrahmanyam** Scientist G (Rtd.) MoEFCC, Delhi gave an invited talk on "*Pollution Prevention/Cleaner Production in Small and Medium Scale Enterprises (SMEs)*". The final invited talk was given by **Shri. Balakrishnan Menon**, Professor, VP Chest Institute, University of Delhi on "*Health Effects of Air Pollution*". At the seminar, young researchers, teachers and students from different colleges and Universities participated and presented their research work at the seminar. The poster session was judged by Dr. B Sengupta and Dr. G.V Subrahmanyam.

ECO CLUB SHIVAJI COLLEGE 2016 -2017

Eco-Club Shivaji College is a highly active society of Shivaji College that organizes a number of environmental awareness programmes and projects from time to time.

Participation in Plantation: On 5th September 2016, Eco Club members participated in planting a tree sapling in the college campus and encouraged the students to plant trees in their backyard.

An invited lecture on Climate Change and India was delivered by **Dr. Subodh Kr Sharma, Former** Advisor of Ministry of Environment Forest and Climate Change in College auditorium on 4th November 2016. Activities like poster making and essay writing competitions were also held. The best poster and essay were judged and given a cash prize along with a certificate. Overwhelming participation was appreciated by the distinguished speaker.

Eco club Shivaji College organized a one day programme in the college campus to create Environmental Awareness on Fuel Conservation on 14th February 2017. The programme included various activities like T-shirt painting, Placard writing, Sticker making and signature campaign. A project on “**Car pool: A sustainable option**” was also launched. A march toward the ring road was also organized to spread awareness in public. College students from different Departments participated in this programme.

T-shirt painting activity was the key event with a total of 30 participants. The 3 best T-shirts were judged and given prizes and certificates. In Placard writing, more than 30 students participated and made placards with informative and pictorial presentations. The best 3 placards were selected and given cash prizes and certificates. An on the spot Sticker Competition was announced on the topic of conservation of fuel and environment. Out of 83 participants, 15 best stickers were selected during the event for certificates.

Signature campaign to ‘**Save Fuel For Better and Safe Future**’ began with the signing of Dr. Shashi Nijhawan, Principal Shivaji College which was later signed by teaching, non-teaching staff members and students.

Some teaching and non-teaching members of the college have also adopted the idea of carpooling to promote “**Carpooling: A sustainable option**”. A group named *Paryavaran Mitra* is formed on whatsapp. Further, mobile based apps are under consideration.

After these activities, more than 400 students and teachers joined the march toward ring road to spread the message of fuel conservation. Students and teachers displayed placards and wore T-shirts and raised slogans Save Fuel Save Environment. Pamphlets were distributed to encourage carpools and adopt ways to minimize fuel consumption. The event was successful in sensitizing and spreading awareness among the teaching and non-teaching staff, students and general public.

Report on the Webinar

organized by Department of English

The Department of English, Shivaji College organized a webinar on ‘Academic Writing on Translating Culture Through Language’ for its Annual Literary Festival ‘Litopia 2020’ on April 29, 2020 from 1.00 p.m. onwards.

The guest speaker invited for the event was Ms. Richa Dawar who is currently working as an Assistant Professor at Daulat Ram College, Delhi University. Dr. Shiv Kumar Sahdev, Acting Principal, Shivaji College inaugurated the session and also spoke to the students about the importance of cultivating one’s mind and to continue learning even in dire times. Dr. Chakpram Priyanka, the Teacher-in-Charge of the department, welcomed the guest speaker and introduced her to the participants. Ms. Dawar delivered an excellent and engaging presentation on the topic ‘Academic Writing on Translating Culture Through Language’ in which she explained in detail the meaning, importance and the need to cultivate academic writing skills for students at undergraduate level. Ms Dawar’s very well-structured and detailed presentation mapped the trajectories of an uphill task of writing an academic paper, the various pitfalls within the domain of academic writing that a young researcher may encounter and fall into, and the various methods to avoid them. She also introduced the students to the concept of plagiarism and the dangers of literary theft in academia, and how students can easily avoid it by learning proper citation, referencing and various other ways of acknowledging source materials. For her presentation, Ms. Dawar referred to a research paper titled “‘He does not understand our customs’”: Narrating orality and empire in Chinua Achebe’s *Things Fall Apart*’ in order to help the student participants understand the concept on methodology of writing and the basic structure of a research paper like an abstract, key words, introductory paragraph, the body of the essay, conclusion and references. After the presentation, Ms. Richa Dawar also readily helped the students in clearing their doubts and queries.

The entire session lasted for about two hours with approximately 45 students and 10 faculty members from the department. The session concluded with a vote of thanks from Dr. Chakpram Priyanka.
