<p>INTRODUCTION</p> <p>The WHO defines health as a state of complete physical, mental and social well-being and not merely the absence of disease or infirmity. Based on their way of living and/or occupational habits, people are predisposed to ailments like diabetes, obesity, depression, high blood pressure, cardiovascular diseases etc. They are preventable and can be lowered with changes in diet, lifestyle and environment. Lifestyle diseases characterise those diseases whose occurrence is primarily based on daily habits of people and as a result of an inappropriate relationship of people with their environment. The main factors contributing to the lifestyle diseases include bad food habits, physical inactivity, wrong body posture, substance abuse and disturbed biological clock. The resultant chronic diseases being diabetes, stroke, cancer, diabetes and respiratory infections which are elements of long duration and slow progression, will severely affect people's earnings. A report jointly prepared by the World Health Organization (WHO) and the World Economic Forum, says India will incur an accumulated loss of US\$ 4 billion by 2015 on account of unhealthy lifestyles and faulty diet. The onset of these lifestyle diseases is insidious, they take years to develop, and once announced do not lend themselves easily to cure. In past few decades we have witnessed a rapid transformation in the lifestyle of Indians, particularly those living in urban India. Economic growth, modernisation, urbanisation & globalization has changed the life style of Indian families, with a shift in eating habits and the adoption of a sedentary life style that has resulted in rapid escalation of lifestyle diseases with alarming perspectives by WHO 2002. That by 2025, seven million Indians may die of lifestyle diseases. Elimination of these risk factors can prevent diabetes, stroke, heart disease by 80% and cancer by 40%. It is said that, the possibility of an Indian suffering from a lifestyle disease is four per cent greater than people from other nationalities and are also affecting younger population.</p> <p>The goal is not only the better of living, but also very much its process. This sustainable group is facing serious health challenges like unhealthy habits and poor hygiene, persistent behavioral risk, poor basic sanitation. These in turn are contributing to a steadily increasing changing the health picture of healthy youth. Global interest in the health of adolescents and youth has mobilised itself in the many expressions of commitment to their healthy personal, spiritual, social, mental and physical development. The health issues relevant to the youth are comprehended by the fact there certain</p>	<p>assessing progress to their lifestyle in particular. Preference to junk food and sweetened drinks, long hours of studying in front of the television, lack of spare time in big cities, excessive peer pressure affecting the young, sedentary mode, as a cause of concern as they may lead to eating disorders, obesity, cardiovascular diseases, diabetes, depression, and poor sleep leading to permanent physical damage.</p> <p>Expected Outcome</p> <p>The symposium aims will help the students to understand the increased risk factors of lifestyle diseases due to a sedentary lifestyle, lack of physical activity, smoking and high intake of alcohol. It will create awareness about the impact of a balanced diet, good posture, abstinence from substance abuse and physical activity. 



RISK ASSESSMENT

- A risk assessment of the infectious agent or toxin and the procedures to be performed is used to determine the **appropriate containment facility, equipment and work practices** that will promote the safe conduct of the research project. Important differences exist between risk assessment criteria for public health and worker protection, and requirements for animal, plant, and agricultural containment.
- A risk assessment is a process used to **identify the hazardous characteristics** of a known infectious agent or toxin or potentially infectious agent, toxin, or material, the activities that can result in exposure to that agent, the **likelihood** that such exposure will cause an infection, and the **probable consequences** of such an infection.
- The information identified through a risk assessment is used to guide the **selection of appropriate microbiological practices, safety equipment, and facility safeguards** that, when used properly, can prevent exposures and dramatically reduce the incidence of laboratory-acquired infections.
- Risk assessment is a common first step in an overall risk management process.

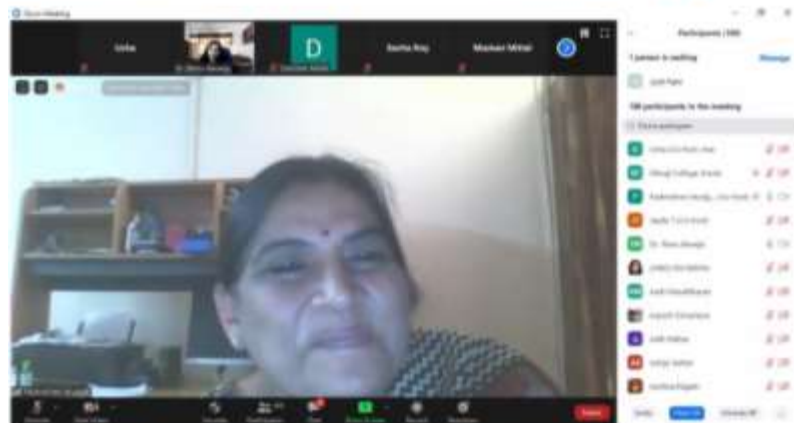
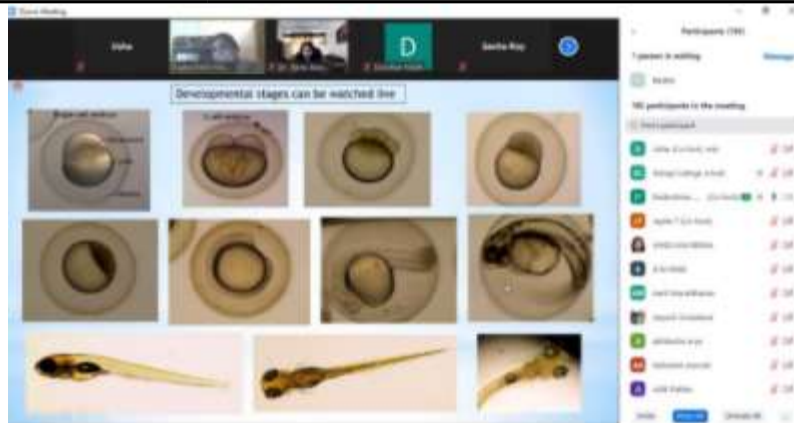

Impact of COVID-19 on Sectors in India

Assumptions*
 The COVID-19 pandemic subsides in India from its peak level and all businesses resume operations from June 2020 onwards, although in a staggered manner.
 Businesses across the globe (excluding China) also resume operations from June 2020, although in a staggered manner.
 More businesses across China resume operations from April 2020 (over 60% of the companies in China have actually resumed in March 2020).

Sectors	Impact	Recovery period	Reasons
Drugs and pharmaceutical	Moderate	Short term	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Production is expected to recover quickly as the government is extending support for essential commodities. Businesses have started resuming operation in China, which accounts for around 85% of India's active pharmaceutical ingredients imports. This alleviates the supply chain disruptions, though not by a great extent.
Livestock	Severe	Short term	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Prices and demand may increase after the outbreak.
Retail (non-food items)	Severe	Short term	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sales of essential items may recover quickly, while sales of non-essential items might take slightly longer to recover. However, pent up demand will aid a fast recovery.
Wholesale (non-food items)	Severe	Short term	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sales of essential items may recover quickly, while sales of non-essential items might take slightly longer to recover. However, pent up demand will aid a fast recovery.
Textiles	Moderate	Short term	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Discretionary spending is expected to remain muted for at least one quarter. However, demand for essential commodities such as masks, cotton rolls, gauzes, etc. will not be negatively impacted. Even if demand for low-priced products starts reviving after a quarter, the uncertainty and slow growth or loss of income may impede a quick recovery for the next two quarters. Exporters will take longer to recover until recessionary pressures in the USA and European countries fade away.


