• <u>*Hindi Diwas*</u> is celebrated on 14th September to celebrate the adoption of Hindi as the official language of the country.




• <u>International Mother Language Day</u> is observed on 21st February, with the aim to promote the preservation and protection of our mother language.




• *International women's day* is celebrated on 8th March.

• <u>International Yoga Day</u> is celebrated since 2015, on 21st June every year.




