Sub: Memorandum of Understanding

Following our meeting on 14 September 2022, we are pleased to confirm our partnership with the Centre for Promotion of Inclusivity at Shivaji College for organising a series of events and activities to build awareness, sensitisation and allyship for Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities. These activities will run through the current academic year, ending July 2023, numbering 3 sessions and 3 student-led activities over a 5 month-long period.

The session themes will be mutually agreed upon between the CFPI and Sarvodya teams. Each delivered session is to be followed by a month for an activity, challenge, affirmative action/project as agreed with the CFPI committee. Below is a non-exhaustive list of ideas discussed in our last meeting, to be finalised with the CFPI team -

- 1. Workshop series introducing neurodiversity, language and ableism, cultivating allyship, place of popular culture in building awareness, intersection with other issues, including gender, socio-economic disadvantage, language
- 2. Month-long windows for projects/activities short-burst campaigns to spread awareness, short film or poster making competitions, movie screening or book club activities, community engagement via Inclusive Duniya Circles and other formats

The Sarvodya Collective will provide the following

- 1. Knowledge partnership on topics related to neurodiversity
- 2. Content and design support for events and projects
- 3. Delivery of workshops
- 4. Working with the CFPI team to design for neuro-inclusion in the college (tbc)

All sessions are delivered on the designated honorarium offered by the college plus reimbursement of travel, materials and any incidental expenses, as pre-agreed and approved by the faculty coordinator

The deliverables expected from CFPI Shivaji College are as follows:-

- 1. Student and community participation ensuring impactful reach pre/post events
- 2. SpreadContent on social media platforms on IDD
- 3. The venue, organising and resourcing the delivery of the workshops and interim projects/activities
- 4. Any permissions needed by the college and otherwise

We are excited about working with your team to cultivate neuro-inclusion and thank you again for the open discussion and your partnership. We look forward to a long and mutually beneficial collaboration as we make a more #InclusiveDuniya together!
