About the Trophy:

The trophy was instituted in the honor of Dr Panjabrao Deshmukh, who founded Shivaji College (University of Delhi) in 1961. He was a renowned farmer's leader, social reformer, and educational activist. He established 'Shivaji Education Society' in 1931, which contributed in establishment of many educational institutions in India. Serving as first agriculture minister of independent India, he organized World Agriculture Fair (1959) in Delhi.

General Plan:

- 1. This is a nationwide undergraduate level competition.
- 2. The model should provide a feasible solution to any of the environmental problem affecting society at large. A working model with a new and innovative idea would be preferred.
- 3. The winner of the competition will be awarded **Panjabrao Deshmukh Memorial Trophy for** '**Innovative Green Model**' along with a cash prize of Rs. **21,000**/-
- 4. Participants should name their model to facilitate classification of teams.

Rules and Regulations:

- 1. Only individual entries are invited.
- 2. The last date for registration is March 22, 2020. The participant should submit an abstract of maximum 250 words through the online registration form.
- 3. Acceptance of abstract will be conveyed by March 23, 2020.
- 4. It will be displayed in the College on March 25, 2020 during the competition.
- 5. The participants are required to answer the questions related to the model.
- 6. The decision of the judges will be final and abiding.
- 7. If model requires electricity for functioning, participant must inform in advance.
- 8. No TA/DA will be provided to the participating individual for the competition.

Criteria of Judgment

The model will be evaluated on the basis of its practicality, degree of novelty, solving the problems, social applicability/usefulness and cost effectiveness.
