NOTIFICATION REGARDING COVID-19 VACCINATION CAMP AT SHIVAJI COLLEGE (UNIVERSITY OF DELHI) FOR 18-PLUS EMPLOYEES

As the country is reeling under its worst Coronavirus surge, Shivaji College in association with Delhi University Health Centre (West Campus) is all set to launch the second phase of the COVID vaccination drive, starting from today at its premises, for the eligible University of Delhi and its colleges' employees, aged between 18-44 years.

The employees will receive the Covishield vaccine, developed by the Oxford-AstraZeneca and manufactured by the Serum Institute of India (SII).

All the permanent/ adhoc teaching and permanent/ contractual non-teaching employees of the University of Delhi and its colleges, aged between 18-44 years shall be vaccinated in the vaccination camp.

Please note that only employees of the workplace, aged between 18-44 years will be allowed to take the vaccination. No outsider and family members/ dependents of the employees will be allowed for the vaccination.

The eligible candidates can walk-in any time between 9:00 am and 05:00 pm (Monday to Friday) and take COVID-19 vaccines without pre-registration on the Co-WIN platform. However, during registration and vaccination at the vaccination centre, for personal identity, along with your Employee ID Card, you can show any one of them:

a. Aadhaar card

b. Driving License

c. PAN card

d. Passport

e. Pension Passbook

f. NPR Smart Card

g. Voter ID (EPIC).

Important note regarding Vaccination for 45 years of age and above:

Please note that our Covaxin Vaccination Centre is being temporarily shut due to non-availability of Covaxin at the vaccination centre. We will resume the vaccination drive for 45+ age group, once the supply of Covaxin is restored at our vaccination centre by the Govt. of NCT of Delhi.
