#### **OUR PROJECTS**

#### **Project Sana**



Enactus Shivaji launched Project Sana in 2019 with the objective of empowering and educating underprivileged women, as well as providing them with an eco-friendly and sustainable solution for menstruation. The objective of the project was also to save the planet from the tonnes of plastic resulting from the disposal of regular sanitary napkins. We achieved it by preventing 216 kg of plastics from going into the oceans. Nearly 60,000 cases of cervical cancer deaths are reported every year in India, two-thirds of which are due to poor menstrual hygiene. The country lacks sufficient resources for menstrual hygiene and healthcare, especially in the underprivileged sections. Ensuring the same is the objective of Project Sana, an initiative by students of Shivaji College. The project is going strong in 2023. In recognition of our efforts, we are proud to announce that we were among the top four finalists in the global competition called Race 4 Oceans, where we competed against 55 teams from more than 33 countries worldwide.







### **OUR PROJECTS**

#### **Project Dritih**



Project Dritih is an initiative that aims to combat animal cruelty through the use of biodegradable waste i.e., orange peel used as the primary raw material. This project bases its foundation to create a low-cost, merchantable and reliable bio-leather. The three main problem statements that have been considered in our project are cruelty, pollution caused by leather industries unmanaged biodegradable waste. Dritih will be the voice of innocent animals and try to save as many lives as possible. We aim to target transgender community for the same and entrepreneurship. We'll employ them to produce our bio leather sheets and hence, wallets and diaries. Therefore, empowering them through a source of income and recognition. We are also benefitting the vendors from whom we source the orange peels (primary raw material) as we are giving them income for their waste. With our various awareness sessions related to animal cruelty we aim to support animal welfare groups.





#### OUR PROJECTS

#### **Project Tahaarat**



Project Tahaarat is a recently launched project that aims to revolutionize the detergent industry by offering an innovative solution that addresses the environmental and health concerns associated with conventional detergents. By harnessing the natural cleaning power of bromelain enzymes found in pineapple waste, we have developed an effective and eco-friendly detergent. We take pineapple waste and transform it into a powerful and eco-friendly detergent through a meticulous process. The pineapple peels are procured and fermented in a solution of water and brown sugar for 4 to 5 weeks. After completion, the mixture is filtered, yielding a dark brown liquid enzyme that serves as the base for the detergent. This enzyme is stored carefully, and coconut oil is added to enhance its cleaning properties. This detergent not only reduces the use of harmful chemicals like bleach and phosphates but also mitigates the pollution and disposal problems caused by pineapple waste. Through this project, we strive to promote sustainable practices, protect marine ecosystems, and contribute to a cleaner and healthier planet for future generations.
