














ARTISTICO'24

ARTISTICO'23

The occasion of the Annual Cultural Festival, VIBRATIONS, VIBGYOR successfully organized ARTISTICO'23 introducing a series of inspiriting events and competitions on 2nd and 3rd February 2023.

Two weeks before the fest, the creation of the models and artefacts that were subsequently used to decorate the college campus, well started. The team chose to repurpose the earlier models it had created for ARTISTICO'22 and transform them all into incredible works of art that complemented the concept of the circus while keeping in mind the issue of waste management.

Final models included- a tall man; a balancing zebra; a direction signboard to guide the students; and an inverted clown. They received positive response on the day of fest as they were ultimate blockbusters.

ARTISTICO officially got the ball rolling with it's very first event, PAINT 'N' POUT- A face painting competition. The theme of "marvels of circus" was provided to the participating teams on the spot. All the teams, as was expected, brilliantly painted their models, with each painting being extraordinary. The esteemed panel selected the deserving winners who received awards worth Rs. 4000 after evaluating each entry's neatness, ingenuity, and connection to the theme.

Up next, VIBGYOR organised another competition, FABULUM PICTURAa relay story panel painting competition revolving around the theme, CIRCUS. The participating teams splendidly painted a story panel with magnificent strokes. The judges decided the winners on the basis of creativity, adherence to the theme and neatness who were presented with cash prizes worth Rs. 4000.

Amidst these events, VIBGYOR also displayed its art exhibition, THE CIRCUS EXPRESS on 2nd and 3rd February, 2023. The members' amazing artwork was used to adorn the given stalls in a significant way. The exhibition gave participants the chance to sell their works, which ranged from mandalas to polaroid paintings to intricate and abstract sketches and illustrations, all of which showed the breadth of their experimentation, thought, and creation. Many of the displayed works of art were also sold.

On the 2nd day of fest, ARTISTICO conducted a CALLIGRAPHY WORKSHOP for VIBGYORIANS by a talented and experienced artist Ms. Tarini. The workshop was curated in the best possible manner. Ms Tarini guided the workshop in a fun way, imparting knowledge on the basics of calligraphy techniques. It was an enriching event where by the end of it, each one of the participants had their sheets filled with vibrant and unique calligraphic patterns.
