International Day of Yoga 2024 - 21.06.2024

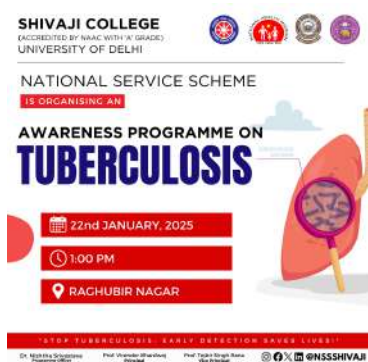
Field Visit to CanKids - 16.01.25

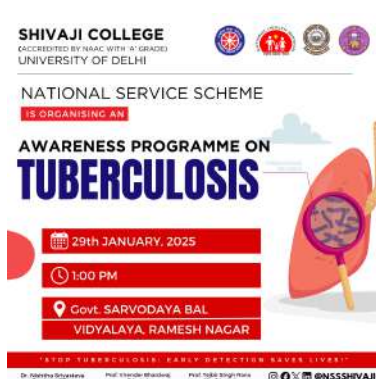
Awareness Campaign on Tuberculosis in Raghur Nagar - 22.01.25
